Article 1. Name

This Agreement shall be known as the Höegh Autoliners/K-Line Space Charter Agreement (the "Agreement").

Article 2. Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to authorize the parties to charter space to/from one another on their respective vessels in the Trade on commercial terms and conditions (as hereinafter defined).

Article 4. Geographic Scope

This Agreement shall cover the trades (a) from ports on the Atlantic Coast of the United States (Eastport, Maine to Key West, Florida range) to ports in north Europe; and (b) from ports in Mexico to ports on the Atlantic Coast of the

United States; and (c) from ports on the West Coast of the United States to ports in Korea, Japan and China (all of the foregoing is hereinafter referred to as the "Trade").
