## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY STAY OF PROCEEDING

This proceeding is before the Commission on the Administrative Law Judge's April 22, 2022 Initial Decision. On May 18, 2022, Respondent Hapag-Lloyd AG and the Bureau of Enforcement (jointly the "Parties") filed a Joint Petition for Approval of Proposed Settlement Agreement and also requested that the deadline for the filing of exceptions to the Initial Decision of the Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding be stayed pending a ruling on this Petition, and that Respondent and BOE be afforded a reasonable amount of additional time to file said exceptions in the event this Petition is denied.

The request to temporarily stay the deadline for the filing of exceptions is granted. Correspondingly, the deadlines for replies to exceptions by BOE, the time for the Commission to seek review of the Initial Decision if exceptions are not filed,<sup>1</sup> and for the Commission's final decision are temporarily stayed until further notice.
