NOTICE OF FILING OF COMPLAINT AND ASSIGNMENT

Notice is given that a complaint has been filed with the Federal Maritime Commission (Commission) by ACME Freight Services Corp., hereinafter “Complainant”, against Total Terminals International, “Respondent”. Complainant alleges that Respondent is a Delaware corporation and marine terminal operator (“MTO”).

Complainant alleges that Respondents violated 46 U.S.C. § 41102(c) and 46 C.F.R. §§ 545.4 and 545.5 with regard to assessing demurrage charges against containers, including containers that are subject to a governmental hold and therefore unavailable for pickup.
