

ORDER GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION TO RESPOND TO DISCOVERY

On July 19, 2022, the parties filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time to serve objections and responses to each other's initial written discovery requests and to begin to notice depositions. The parties state that they are working diligently and collaboratively to finalize the documentation necessary to give effect to the Parties' agreement in principle to settle this proceeding. Motion at 1. The parties request a two-week extension from July 25, 2022, to August 8, 2022.

Good cause having been stated for the extension, the request is approved. The parties previously obtained a two-week extension of this deadline. If a settlement is not finalized by August 8, 2022, the parties should be prepared to continue with discovery while discussing settlement. This order does not change other deadlines in the proceeding. If the parties reach a settlement, they should file a motion requesting approval with a copy of the settlement agreement.
