PROPOSED JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Initial Order in this case and FMC Rule § 502.141(h), attorney Carlos Rodriguez representing Globberunners conferred with John J. Sullivan, counsel representing Hoyer Global (USA), Inc. Both parties propose the following joint status report.

SCHEDULING AND DISCOVERY PLANS WERE AGREED TO AS FOLLOWS:


1. Pursuant to 46 C.F.R. § 502.64(a), the Parties have not conferred with the Director of the Commission's Office of Consumer Affairs and Dispute Resolution Services and are not scheduling a mediation at this time.
2. Initial interrogatories, requests for production, and requests for admission, pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 33 and 34 shall be served on opposing parties by **February 1, 2023**.
3. **Discovery** shall be completed by **April 7, 2023** (no later than **150 days** after the service of the respondent's answer to the complaint. FMC R. §502.141(g). Any written interrogatories or request for production served after the date of the Scheduling and Discovery Order shall be served by a date that allows the served parties the full **30 days** as provided by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure in which to answer or produce by the discovery cut-off date.
4. The parties are reminded that, prior to filing any motions concerning discovery, they must

first meet and confer relating to any discovery disputes and then contact the Administrative Law Judge to arrange a telephone discovery dispute conference if they are unable to resolve their dispute(s). If the dispute cannot be resolved in the first telephonic conference, the parties agree to submit input of the parties on the discovery issues in writing for resolution by the Administrative Law Judge on an expedited basis.
