

ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE BRIEFS

On August 18, 2023, Complainant filed an emergency unopposed motion to extend the time to file briefs (“Motion”). The motion requests an extension of two days based on delays in completing expert depositions and preparing final briefing. Complainant states that this “is SEA’s first request for an extension, which SEA submits is both modest and reasonable, and that reasonable grounds exist to grant the extension of time.” Motion at 2. The motion asserts that Respondent does not object to the extension of time as long as it is afforded a like amount of time. The extension will result in final briefing filed two business days after the date previously scheduled.

Good cause having been stated for the short requested extension, the motion is **GRANTED**. The final deadline has been changed as October 9, 2023, is a federal holiday. The parties shall abide by the following schedule:
