

ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER

On November 18, 2022, Respondent filed a motion requesting an extension of time to respond to the complaint. Respondent requests an extension from November 21, 2022, to December 19, 2022. Respondent states that “Senior representatives of the parties met in person on Wednesday, November 16 to discuss the possibility of an amicable resolution” and that “[b]oth parties are of the view, based on that meeting, that there is a realistic possibility of reaching agreement on a resolution of this matter by year’s end.” Motion at 1. The motion further indicates that counsel for Complainant has no objections to the requested extension.

This is a longer extension than is typically permitted at this stage. However, the parties have shown good faith by meeting and working to resolve the proceeding. Accordingly, good cause is shown and the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Respondent shall respond to the complaint by December 19, 2022.
