

**AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER**

On December 18, 2023, the parties filed a joint motion to amend the scheduling order. The parties state that they have exchanged initial disclosures and discovery requests, have been undertaking collection and review of documents, and have a mediation scheduled with the Office of Consumer Affairs & Dispute Resolution Services on January 9, 2024. The parties request a 30-day extension of the schedule. The proposed amended schedule is reasonable and will permit the Initial Decision to be issued by August 28, 2024, as required by the Commission. The parties should not expect any additional extensions. Therefore, the motion is **GRANTED**.

The parties are hereby **ORDERED** to follow this schedule:

January 19, 2024	Discovery responses due and completion of document production.
February 15, 2024	Begin fact depositions.
February 29, 2024	Complete fact depositions.
March 20, 2024	Close of all discovery.
April 8, 2024	Complainant's brief, proposed findings of fact, and appendix.
May 6, 2024	Respondent's opposition brief, responses to proposed findings of fact, proposed findings of fact, and appendix.
May 20, 2024	Complainant's reply brief and responses to proposed findings of fact.
