**JOINT STATUS REPORT AND
PROPOSED DISCOVERY SCHEDULE**

Pursuant to 46 C.F.R. §502.141(h) and the August 29, 2023 Initial Order, Complainants, Hubbell Incorporated (“Hubbell Incorporated”) and HUBS, Inc. (“HUBS”) (each a “Complainant” and collectively “Complainants” or “Hubbell”), and Respondents, DSV Air & Sea, Inc. and DSV Ocean Transport A/S (together, “DSV” or “Respondents”) (collectively the “Parties”), by their respective undersigned counsel, have conferred and submit this joint status report and proposed discovery schedule.

Initial Disclosures. The Parties have agreed to exchange Initial Disclosures by Wednesday, October 25, 2023.

CADRS. The Parties have submitted a joint request to the Commission’s Office of Consumer Affairs and Dispute Resolution Services (“CADRS”) requesting a joint meeting, or separate meetings, to discuss the potential for dispute resolution in connection with this proceeding. A meeting or meetings with CADRS has not yet been scheduled, but is anticipated this week.

Discovery Schedule. The Parties conferred and submit the following proposed discovery schedule intended to complete discovery within the Commission’s discovery period, and attempting to be mindful of the upcoming holidays.

Expert Testimony. The Parties do not presently anticipate the use of expert witnesses, but will confer and advise the Presiding Officer if that should change.

Confidential Information. The Parties anticipate that some materials, such as sensitive commercial information, may require confidential treatment and will work cooperatively with respect to a confidentiality stipulation.
