ORDER GRANTING CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER

On April 3, 2024, Respondents Orient Overseas Container Line Limited and OOCL (Europe) Limited filed a consent motion to extend their time to file an answer from April 22, 2024 to May 13, 2024. Respondents' counsel cites preplanned travel out of the country from April 16 to April 29, 2024 as the reason for the extension. Commission Rule 102 provides for enlargement of time upon filing of a motion at least seven days before the scheduled filing date and a showing of good cause. The motion complies with the rule, Complainant consents to the request, and I find good cause for the extension.

The motion is therefore **GRANTED**; Respondents must file their answer no later than **May 13, 2024**. I remind the parties of the Initial Order's requirement that they participate in a preliminary conference with the Commission's Office of Consumer Affairs and Dispute Resolution Services and submit a joint state report with a propose scheduled within 15 days of service of the answer.
